





## **Keep your Porsche the Envy of the Block**

Ferry Porsche once said, "I wanted to build cars that were not something to everyone but meant everything to some." I have yet to meet a Porsche owner that isn't obsessively in love with his or her Porsche. The unmatched speed mixed with precise handling and perfectly sculpted bodylines - its no wonder people who own them love them so much. As an owner of a 07' Turbo and 97' C4S. I understand that thrill. Part of showing adoration for your Porsche is keeping it in pristine condition. Two of the most popular and effective ways of preserving your vehicle's paint are applying: (1) clear bra to the most vulnerable high impact areas and (2) a high-grade ceramic coating on the remainder of the painted finish.

Since 2001, my business has been dedicated to the protection and preservation of Porsches and other high-end vehicles. We started out as a full service detailing company, and in 2007 began offering paint protection film(a.k.a. Clear Bra) services. In 2014 we expanded again to include Ceramic Coatings.

Based on my extensive experience in the industry, I have seen both the good and the bad when it comes to clear bra and coating applications. In this article I want to share my knowledge about these products and provide tips for people who are considering clear bra and/or coatings for their vehicle.

#### What is Clear Bra?

Clear Bra is a transparent and nearly invisible polyurethane film that is designed to protect the most vulnerable areas of your vehicle's paint from permanent damage caused by road debris, rocks, gravel, salt, bird droppings, insects, and other environmental contaminants. This technology was originally developed for the military during the Vietnam War to protect helicopter rotor blades from shrapnel and debris. In the 80's, the racecar industry adopted the technology as a way to protect the painted finish to optimize aerodynamics. By the 90's clear bra was being used by average drivers, and its popularity has continued to increase since then. The quality of today's film is the best it has ever been!

What is Ceramic Coating? A Ceramic Coating is a liquid

polymer that is applied to the painted finish of a vehicle to protect against environmental contaminants. It is not a substitute for clear bra, rather, it forms a permanent bond with the painted surface so it does not degrade over a short period of time like a wax or sealant. Once applied, it provides outstanding hydrophobic properties and superior resistance to micro-marring, chemical etching, and fading due to UV exposure. Additionally, a Ceramic Coating adds gloss and slickness for a fantastic shine and long-term paint protection. Clear bra and ceramic coatings are complimentary of one another and are typically applied at the same time.

## Tips for Finding a Clear Bra and Coating Specialist

When looking for a trusted company, there are four key tips to help ensure you receive quality work:

1. Do your homework: Knowledge is power. At a minimum, it is important to have a basic understanding of the products and services that may be right for you and your vehicle. This can be accomplished several ways. I recommend doing internet research by visiting product manufacturer websites and online forums. It is also a good idea to speak with someone who has had similar work done to his or her vehicle.

2. Find prospective shops: After you have a basic understanding of the products, the next step is finding the right shop to do the work. No two shops are the same, and work quality varies significantly from shop to shop. I've been applying clear bra to high-end

vehicles for almost 11 years, and I am still learning. When it comes to clear bra, select a company that has years (plural!) of experience. Unlike the application of a ceramic coating, clear bra is a highly skilled craft that takes years and years to master. Being able to "install" film is one thing, but perfecting the application is another.

3. Ask the right questions: During your initial call with a prospective shop, gather as much information as possible in order to inform your final decision. Consider asking the following questions: What product brands do you offer, and why? How long have you been working with these products? Who will be performing the services on my vehicle? How long does the process take? How do you prepare the car before applying clear bra or a ceramic coating? What does the warranty cover? Can you show me examples of your work? Can you provide any recent customer references?

4. Make a shop visit: Once you narrow your search to a few shops, I suggest scheduling a shop visit. This gives you the opportunity to inspect the work first hand, and determine if what was said over the phone is consistent with reality. Whenever I speak with potential clients, I always encourage them to visit our shop in person. While at a shop, inspect the vehicles closely. When looking over clear bra installation in particular, pay attention to the edges. Are they wrapped completely around each panel? Is the film free of defects and blemishes like stretch marks? Shops can have stellar reviews on sites like Yelp or Google, but seeing the work in person will corroborate what you have heard and read. Visit a shop to see vehicles in the various stages of the clear bra and coating processes. I hope these four tips help to make your paint protection decisions a bit "clearer."






