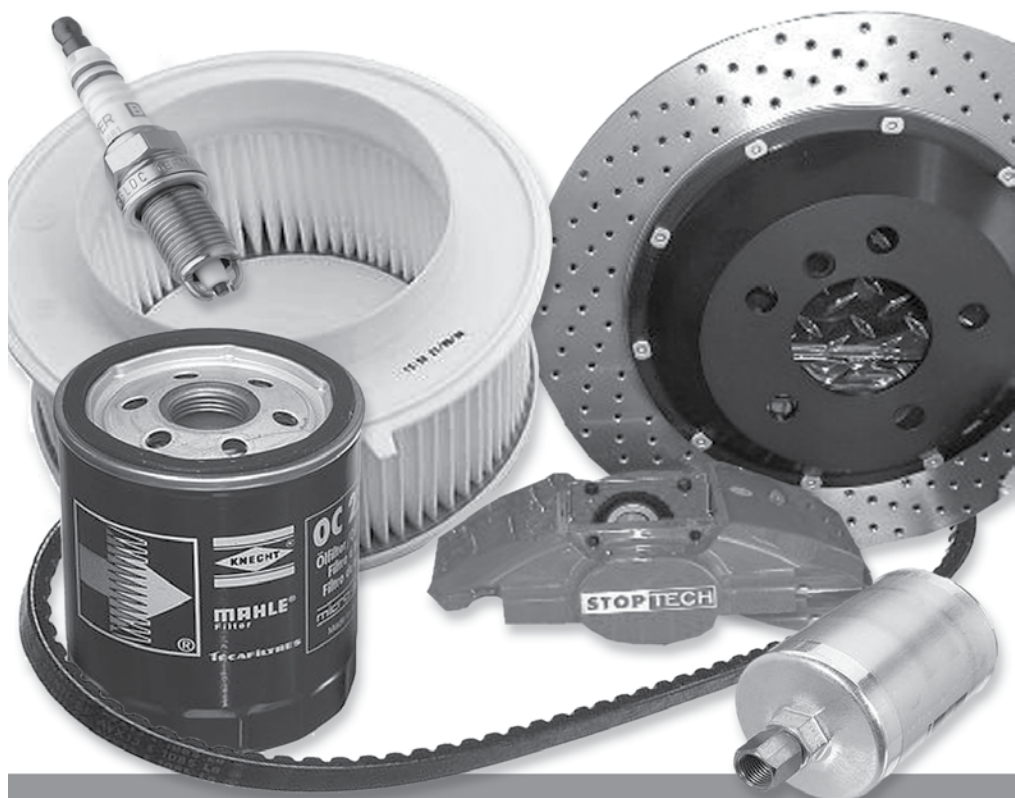

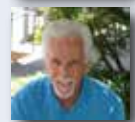

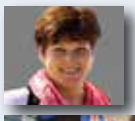

M_AX Fun

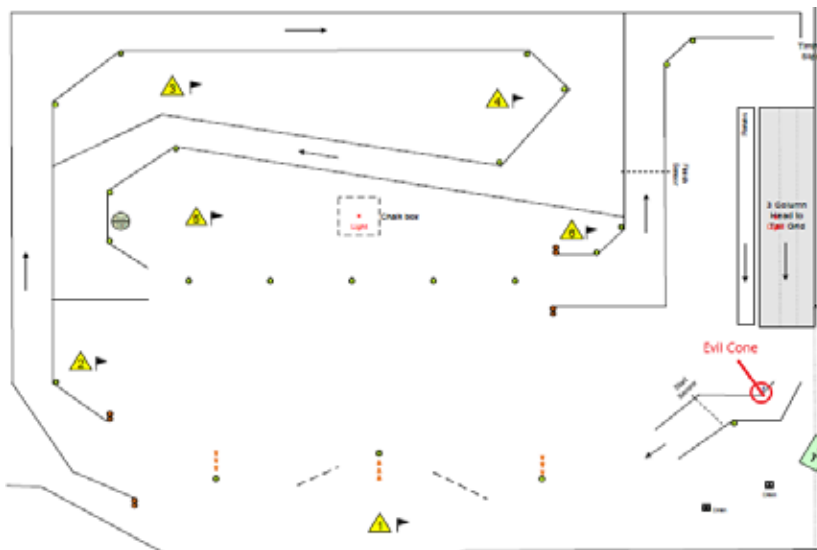

We had a good day for the fourth SVR event of the season. Registration started off VERY slowly and as of a week before the event we only had about 35 drivers, BUT those late registrations came in and we ended up with our sneaking in at 51. The temperature was creeping up there but still reasonable in the shade so people gathered in the shady areas when possible. A Breeze kicked in in the afternoon that kept things nice. Setup went well and the first cars were out shortly after 9 AM. Thanks to the many Autocross team members and other volunteers that showed up at 6:30 (or earlier) to ensure that everything got off to a good start.

For the 51 drivers we worked in a total of 9 runs each with 5 in the AM while things were still cool and a vote at lunch between 3 or 4 runs was nearly unanimous at 4 so that's what we went with. Please note that all of those voting for 3 runs did not boycott the fourth run and took them anyway yielding to the majority. We continue to have new drivers showing up at our events and look forward to seeing again. Another item of note, is that the number of female participants has been steadily increasing and we had 9 female drivers attending just shy of 20%. If you are one of the drivers attending your first few events, PLEASE reach out to us and let us know what we did well and of course how can help make your experience even better for next time. We look forward to your input (autocross@svr-pca.org)

For our fourth event of the season we enjoyed another great course titled "Grand Finale" designed Kent Treiber.

The course is aptly named as this will be Kent's last event before he heads south to Arizona permanently. Kent's decided not to pay for flights down for the remaining events of the season and driving other team members cars. We pointed out that the cost savings in his super sticky tires would more than offset the expense of the flights but he's declined none the less. We'll miss his presence on the team and course designs which have fantastic over the last few years. Kent took last month off for the evil cone placement, however



was back with a sneaky placement of a cone that was JUST before the start timer at this event that frequently "jumped" under tires if people were not careful at the start (see marked area to left). Yes, cones before AND after the start do count against you. The course started off quickly with a set of widely space offset slaloms which lined you up for the "need for speed section" with two linked straights that got you moving before you tested your ABS brakes at turn four, which had plenty of room for the turn but had to be taken JUST right to get the optimal time. Few drivers nailed that turn perfectly in a consistent fashion, but when drivers did navigate juuuuuust right they usually

netted their top time. The tight turn around station four was followed by a short straight and less abrupt turn leading in to a slalom and left hand turn leading to the finish line. Many people had a tough time with that last turn to the finish and skirted the right-side cones and some event went a bit sideways either before, during or after crossing the finish line. One individual, Matt Deter, was even successful at all three during separate runs (sideways before, crossing, or after the finish) but managed to avoid cones across multiple

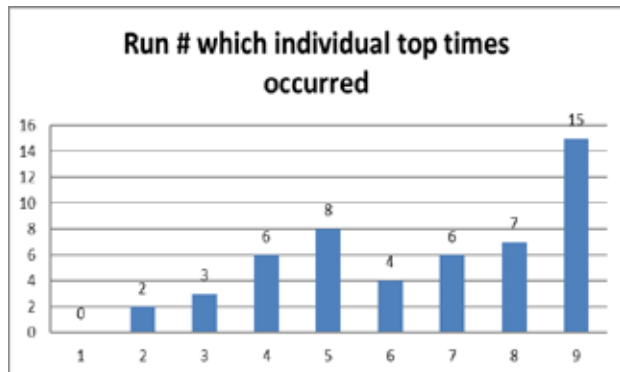
applause worthy finishes. Thank you Matt!!! As noted earlier Kent will be relinquishing his role as our primary course designer. Kent will be assisting us through the end of the season and we've had a few expressing interest in taking their hands at this, so if you want to aid in course design let us know and we'll work with you.

Average Times: Average run times dropped by three seconds fairly quickly due to the nature of the VERY

slippery first run and snuck back up for the fifth run and decreased strongly through the end of the day and people tied together the two straights and continued work on that ever important turn at the end of the two straights.

Top Times of Day: We had a large portion of drivers getting their top times in the afternoon with 63% of drivers getting their TTOD in the afternoon and a full 29% getting their best run on the 9th and final run.

Ladies Top Time: For the ladies things started off very close!!! Kat Johnston started things off with a first run of 38.524 setting the target for the ladies.



Vern Thomas was close behind with a time of 39.561. The next run group came up and Joy Nieslony nabbed the lead with a First run time a mere 6/100th faster than Kat, which nabbed Joy the top spot. Joy held the top spot and steadily improved her times getting her best morning run on the 5th run at 37.201 and then missing the 36's ever so slightly with a 9th run time of 37.008. Kat and Vern while improving on successive runs chased but could not quite top Joy's final run.

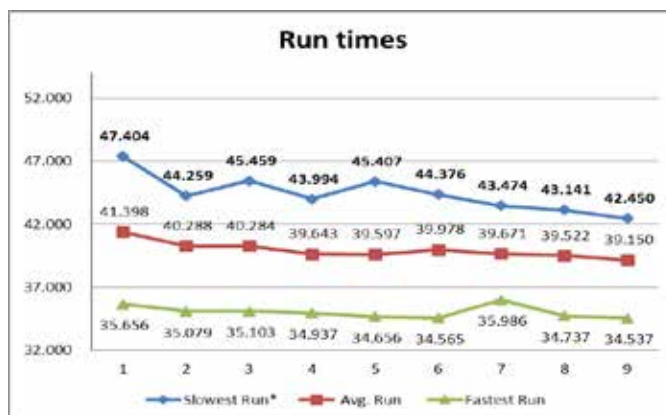
Men's Top Time: Top time traded places a number of times during the day and was very close with the top six Porsche's all within 1.2 seconds from one another. Steve Nieslony set the bar with a first run time of 35.656 with three people hot on his heels with times <1 second away. On the second run Kent Treiber shaved off a ½ second from his initial run and nabbed the top place with a time of 35.369. Times remained tight and Kent's time remained on top until the 8th run when John Leet dashed across the finish line with a 35.280. Unfortunately for John the democratic vote of 3 vs. 4 runs would not work in his favor as Kent Treiber managed to tie together his best set of corners on the 9th and final run, smoking across the line with a time of 35.021 and nabbing the top Porsche spot. You may have noticed that Randy Wonnenberg was showing the fastest overall time. Randy officially took the TTOD on his second run and improved until his final run where he nabbed a 34.537 for the non-Porsche TTOD. It is a PCA event after all ☺.

PAX (Performance Adjustment Index) is an adjusted top time based on assigned handicaps based on vehicle make/model/year and level of modification and handicaps are based on actual performance of cars in multiple PCA AX events over the years. The adjustment allows for comparison of times on a more even playing

field. Top 5 PAX times of for our PCA members were from John Leet (S11-2012 Cayman S) had a solid 8th run putting him into the first PAX spot with a time of 33.340. Bob Peake (S11-2010 Carrera S) in 2nd at 33.940 with Steve Nieslony (P16 2007 Cayman S) at 33.941, Alan Garcia (S06-2009 Cayman with 34.217, and Wayne Guerin (S07 2014-Cayman S) at 34.222.

Fun Stuff:

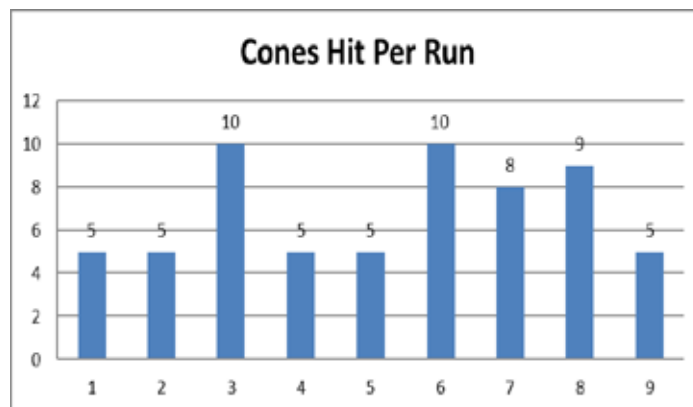
Most Improved: Below are the individuals that showed strong improvements between first reasonable run (run one or two) and best run. The average participant saw an average of about 5% which equates to around 2.3 seconds. The biggest improvement came from Chrstine Warren 15% or 6.9 seconds during the day with a best time of 45.903. Justin Smith 10% during the



day and shaved off 4.3 seconds with a best time of 38.339. Tred Gsines 10% saving 4.7 seconds with a time

of 43.026, Eric Molgaard 10% & 4 Seconds, and finally, Greg Burgeson with 9% shaving off 3.9 seconds. Wonderful job everyone.

Consistency: One of fun measures is who's the most consistent. This takes your three best runs of the day and determines a standard deviation for those runs. The lower the value, the more consistent your runs were. Greg Zajic varied by a mere 32/1000 of a second. Albert Dennis 48/1000 of a second difference followed by Randy Wonnenberg at 0.062, Steve Nieslony.065, and Gurtej Singh 0.066.



Coneage: We ended up with a 62 cones bumped out of the box, thrown in the air or downright squashed. Nearly twice what occurred last month when we quite a few more participants/runs. Things were relatively light to start but got worse and spiked in the afternoon with only 23 drivers managing to navigate the course with nary an cone displaced.

Cone King and Queen: Be aware, we do NOT recognize for avoiding cones, so please don't look for your name here if you were successful in those endeavors. We ended up with a record 49 cone dodging individuals who managed to avoid hitting any cones (Please keep the course workers from getting bored... hit some cones). The remaining 14 were responsible for the quivering cones and keeping the course workers awake. The King and Queen
