A Time Speed Distance (TSD) Road Rally Saturday, April 26, 2025

The rally starts and finishes in Cameron Park, CA. The start is at the Safeway parking lot, 3380 Coach Ln, Cameron Park, and will finish at the Moonraker Millhouse, 3501 Robin Ln, Cameron Park.

The Spring Flowers Rally is designed to be fun for all with simple instructions and a scenic route using well maintained, paved, public roads. 2025 Sacramento Valley Region (SVR) Time-Speed-Distance (TSD) Rally Series

Open to all members in all Regions.

The Sacramento Valley Region (SVR) of the Porsche Club of America will be hosting a series of Time-Speed-Distance (TSD) road rallies that start at various locations within the greater Sacramento Region.

Prior to the first event of the series, SVR will have a TSD Rally School to include a classroom session providing an overview of rally procedures including how to follow route instructions and an introduction to the Richta timing system. The classroom session will be followed by a short practice rally.

The rallies are scheduled for Saturdays with the first car departing at 9:31 AM. They will typically be 90 to 120 miles in length and less than four hours in duration. The rallies will have reasonably easy to follow directions using mostly scenic low volume paved roads.

Route instructions will be consumable for the beginning rallyist but still providing challenges and learning experiences for all participants.
